2014 Conference Planning:

ICES, July 13-17, Tuscon, Arizona, USA – Ted Hall

- Although we did not solicit any for this year, we received 5 abstracts and have 3 papers in review. At least one more review is needed. Päivi Jukola volunteered.

AIAA Space Forum, August 4-7, San Diego, California, USA – Jacky Silva-Martinez

- TWH (via e-mail from JS): There are 5 sessions in the RSA track: 2 SATC paper sessions; 2
 SARTC paper sessions; 1 joint poster session. 28 abstracts were received; 2 transfered;
 3 rejected; leaving 23 abstracts in the RSA track.
- TWH: As part of the forum's "integration layer," SATC has a chance to use the exhibit hall stage and 50-inch plasma screen for a 30-minute coffee break. We need someone to take charge of organizing a slide show, video loop, or some other exhibition.
- TWH: All members should plan to attend the Space Forum so that the SATC can have an effective face-to-face business meeting. Members committed to travel and attend face-to-face meetings when they joined the SATC. TCs are supposed to have at least two face-to-face business meetings per year. Many TCs have full-day meetings. AIAA will provide a room and a catered meal. SATC needs to start planning.

IAC, September 29 - October 3, Toronto, Ontario, Canada – Olga Bannova, Barbara Imhof, Päivi Jukola, Regina Peldszus, Brent Sherwood, Jacky Silva-Martinez

- OB: Preparations ongoing. Space and Society, Art in Space, 2 full sessions. (Background noise made it difficult to hear.)
- RP: Session chaired by RP, BI, and JS focusing on interactive aspects of space architecture.

2015 Conference Planning:

ICES, Time and Place TBD

- TWH: ICES traditionally meets at the same time every year the most likely dates for 2015 are July 12-16. Every fifth year (which would include 2015) it traditionally meets in Europe.
- Marc Cohen proposes to organize the Third International Space Architecture Symposium in conjunction with the next "international" ICES in 2015, or possibly 2016.

Annual Report:

- TWH: All members should review the 2013 Annual Report and Scoresheet (e-mailed December 31) and consider how to improve the SATC's performance as a Committee (not just a collection of individuals doing their own things).

SATC Administration:

- There was some discussion of TC memership limits. AIAA sets limits of 35 regular members and 15 non-regular (alumni + associate + international). The maximum TC membership of 50 derives from the sum of 35 + 15. If a TC has less than 35 regular members, it still may not have more than 15 non-regular. SATC is at its limit of 15 international members (0 alumni and 0 associate).
- Outgoing Chair Ted Hall will prepare a Procedures document to clarify processes.
- New Chair Ondřej Doule, Vice Chair David Wong, and members officially begin their terms on May 1.
- The Secretary position is open.
- Next election will be in December 2015. Everyone should consider nominating themselves.
