# **Awards SC:**

OD, RM: 2015 Best Paper was "What Do We Give Up and Leave Behind" (Cohen and Haeuplik-Meusburger). Runner-up was "International Space Station Acoustics – A Status Report" (Allen). AIAA provided funding of SATC awards in total amount of \$300 against application submitted by Renee Matossian in 2015!

RM: We plan to use \$200 for the Professional "Best Paper" Award (split between co-authors), and the remaining \$100 for the inaugural Student "Best Paper" prize.

We would like to use the 2016 funding request to cover these prizes (especially since student award overlaps 2015-2016 academic year), and leave the remaining \$100 in our SATC account available for other SATC Committee projects.
