## IAC

- IAC2017 Adelaide
  - o 8-9 talks in sessions, better attended than last year. 20-30s
  - Varied quality of papers discussion on how to enhance quality for next session.
  - o Elon Musk's presentation at IAC about " cabin" rather than "seat"?
- IAC2018 Bremen
  - Barbara, Brent & Olga to co-chair IAC Bremen.
  - Aimto get all six contractors of NASA Nextstep2 prototypes to represent, no solid plan yet.
  - Brand Griffin offered to help connecting to the right people

## ICES

- ICES 2017 Charleston
  - Seven presentations in the biggest room at the conference. Audience turnout maxed out at 70.





- ICES 2018
  - Will be chaired by Francois Levy, co-chaired by Georgi Petrov, Sandra Haeuplik-Meusburger and Donald Barker.
  - Abstract submission deadline November 10th

## SAS

- Initial Planning
  - David Wong formed SAS task group on Facebook as an experiment ineffective, will revert back to typical email correspondence.
  - Much discussion about how to get it going. Who is willing? What is the objective? Who is going to attend? Perhaps to be determined by the person who is going to lead on the effort?

## AIAA Space Forum

- Space 2017
  - 19 papers & 4 posters published out of 42 abstracts received. Rejected 6 at abstract level.
  - conducted an informal paper review process which was moderately successful allowed improvement to the content of several papers from first time authors.
  - $\circ$   $\;$  still in the process of determining best paper candidates.
- Space 2018
  - Sam Wald to lead on effort for Space 2018 organization.

## Outreach

- Mars City Design
  - Brent reported on the "platform" gala event the design competition is in its 4<sup>th</sup> year operation, had a lot of entries, the gala event had around 100 ppl attendance included international attendances. Nice event with posters displayed. Award presentations in different categories.
  - Still low in technical fidelity, lacking in engineer vigor, but delivers in attracting people to engage with space. Diversitfy inclusivity.
  - Should SATC engage proactively? Brent recommends not unless MCD invites technical review/participation
- Spacearchitect.org hack
  - Website was hacked last month, briefly redirecting visitor to malware site. The hack utilized a back door vulnerability remained from the previous website attack back in 2014.
  - Website has now subscribed to a website security service.
  - $\circ$  Further technical works to be completed (e.g. setup firewall, SSL, etc.)
  - $\circ$   $\;$  More webmaster stuff needs to be done...need a real webmaster.
- student enquiries.
  - Standing action. Many great suggestions from previous telecom such as FAQ pages, Wikipedia, etc. need to be followed up. Not much has been done since last telecom.
