All our members are therefore strongly encouraged to get involved in presenting papers or organizing space architecture sessions in various space conferences.

Individuals who have not actively participated or contributed to SATC-supported events will be notified and given an opportunity to provide evidence of activities, or to reengage immediately. Lack of response or sustained inactivity may lead to removal from the SATC member roster.
